25 Tue St. Epiphanius, bishop of Cyprus (403). St. Germanus, patriarch of
Constantinople (740). St. Sabinus, archbishop of Cyprus (V).

26 Wed Mid-Pentecost or Prepolovenie. Virgin-martyr Glyceria at Heraclea (141)
and with her Martyr Laodicius, jailer of St. Glyceria (ca. 177). Venerable Euthymius of
Athos the translator (1028) (Georgia).

27 Thu Martyr Isidore of Chios. St. Isidore, fool-for-Christ, wonderworker of Rostov.
Venerable Nicetas, bishop of Novgorod- recluse of the Kiev Caves.

28 Fri Venerable Pachomius the Great (348). St. Isaiah, bishop and wonderworker
of Rostov (1090). Venerable Achilles, bishop of Larissa (330).

17.00 Vespers.

29 Sat Venerable Theodore the Sanctified (368). St. Alexander, archbishop of
Jerusalem. Monk-martyrs of the community of St. Sava the Sanctified.

30 Sun Sunday of the Samaritan Woman. Apostle Andronicus of the Seventy and his fellow laborer Junia. St. Stephen, archbishop of Constantinople (893).
